EVENT FAQs

What are the courses like?

The event will feature 3 courses designed for different skill levels:

- Bow Spider Course (Intermediate) – 25 targets ranging from 30–70 yards, focused on technical shot placement
- Garmin Course (Advanced) – 25 targets ranging from 25–75 yards, with steep angles and skill-testing shots
- MKC Course (Expert) – 25 targets ranging from 40–100 yards, featuring steep angles and more challenging shots

I am already registered; can I add people to my group who haven't registered yet?

Yes – if space is still available. Have them visit the registration page and select your specific Nock Time. If openings remain, they can register and join your group. If the time slot is full, they will need to select a different Nock Time.

What time do I need to show up?

You are welcome to arrive anytime the event is open to use the warm-up range. If you plan to arrive just for your Nock Time, please allow at least 30 minute prior to that time to check in.

Are there any limitations on what gear we can use?

- Broadheads are NOT allowed at any time.
- Crossbows are permitted for participants who are unable to use compound or traditional bows.

How long will it take me to finish a course?

Most participants complete a course in 2.5 to 3.5 hours, depending on individual pace and physical ability.

Is this a competition?

No. This is a non-competitive event focused on having fun, challenging yourself, and enjoying the experience.

Are refunds allowed?
